Morning Arrival Procedures

The arrival procedures will be as follows:

BUS RIDERS: Will be dropped off in the morning at the main entrance. The students are to proceed directly to the cafeteria.

CAR RIDERS: All students are to enter the school through the main front door (no earlier than 7:30 am). Therefore, parents have an option to either park in the lot and walk their children to the front door or pull up and drop children off. We will continue to have someone to help children exit cars and, again, we ask parents not to get out of cars so as to keep traffic moving. It is important that traffic does not back up onto Wyoming Avenue.

Parents are not to walk children into the building.
Teachers will be available to supervise children.

No student is to go to the classrooms until the teacher on duty instructs them to. For the safety of the students, this policy must be strictly adhered to every morning.
