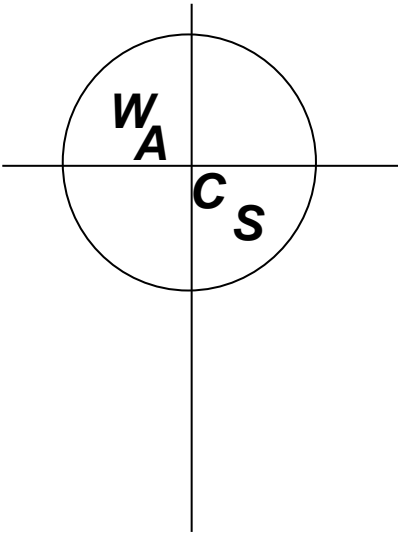


The Precepts of the Church
